Introduction

Welcome to the 2018-2019 Victorian Inter-School Cycling Series. This is the sixth round of seven races. The event will start with a Team Time-Trial, or TTT, and finish with graded Criteriums. The event is located on the Casey Fields circuit in Cranbourne.

This event is coordinated by Cycling Victoria.

Event Location

The Casey Fields Criterium Circuit is located in Cranbourne. It can be accessed from Casey Fields Boulevard, off Berwick-Cranbourne Road.

Parking

Parking is located next to the circuit. There is also ample parking around Casey Fields No 5.

Entries

All individual entries must be made on EntryBoss. On the day entries will not be permitted due to the use of transponders.

Registration

Upon arrival at the event village, riders must visit registration to check their name off and receive their number and transponder. Riders must register at least 30 minutes before the start of their race. Registration will open at 10:15am.

Bib Numbers

Bib numbers must be attached to the lower part of the jersey, in a central position. Numbers must be returned at the end of the event.

Transponders

This event will be electronically timed. Riders must fit a transponder to their bike forks, as shown below. Riders will be supplied with two cable ties, extra cable ties are available. It is recommended that entrants bring their own pliers to remove the transponder at the end of the event.

Transponders must be returned at the end of the event. Riders returning transponders to Cycling Victoria after the event will be charged a \$20 administration fee. Lost or damaged transponders will result in a \$130 charge invoiced to the rider.



Team Time-Trial

Event Start Times and Distances

The first team will set off at 11:31am. Teams will be set off from a standing start, without other support. The rider will be advised of 10 seconds to go, with the last five seconds to go counted down. Teams will be set off in one minute intervals.

All teams must be at the start area 15 minutes before their start time. Late teams will start between other rider times, with the elapsed time considered started.

Teams will be graded: junior female, junior male, senior female, senior male.

Mixed teams may compete in the mens grades, girls only for the female grades. A junior rider may ride with a senior team, must complete the senior distance. Senior riders will not be allowed to ride in junior grades.

Male or mixed teams must finish with three riders to record a time. Female teams must finish with two riders to record a time. All teams may start with a maximum of four riders.

Entrants in the junior grade will ride 5 laps (11km), senior teams will complete 7 laps (15.4km).

A race-day secretary will be appointed to help with changes to the composition of teams. In case of a no-show, assistance with this role will be appreciated and your service will be paid for.

Please note that due to the large number of teams that may be on the circuit, we will be unable to track the number of laps teams have to complete. Parents, guardians and teachers are advised to let their teams know the number of laps left.

The first time juniors complete a circuit, they will have 4 laps to go.

Senior teams will have 6 laps to go after their first lap.

Please note, team presentations will be held at the end of the event program.

Criterion

Rider marshals are welcome in this portion of the event. To ride you must:

- Present a current WWCC or VIT at registration and be signed in
- CA license (ride minimum) is preferred
- Wear a fluoro vest
- Present yourself to the chief commissaire (Jamie) for briefing.
- Never lead out riders unless under commissaire instruction and remain a minimum two bike lengths behind riders they are following
- Only provide safety instruction for riders
- Coaching or riding in an unsafe manner while marshalling will not be permitted.
