Introduction

Welcome to the 2018-2019 Victorian Inter-School Cycling Series. This is the final round of seven races, consisting of a criterium on the Kew Teardrop Circuit. The circuit is located at Yarra Boulevard. This round will award the winners of the individual grades and the top overall school.

This event is coordinated by Cycling Victoria.

Event Location

The teardrop circuit is located at the end of the Yarra Boulevard, just off Studley Park Road, between the suburbs of Abbotsford and Kew.

Parking

The Teardrop circuit is closed to traffic. Parking is available along Yarra Boulevard. Spots will be reserved for official vehicles, such as first aid.

Marquees

All marquees must be set up on the inside of the course loop. The road outside the loop is not part of the event permit and marquee owners will be asked to shift if set up there

Entries

All individual entries must be made on EntryBoss. On the day entries will not be permitted due to the use of transponders.

Registration

Upon arrival at the event village, riders must visit registration to check their name off and receive their number and transponder. Riders must register at least 30 minutes before the start of their race. Registration will open at 8:15am.

Bib Numbers

Bib numbers must be attached to the lower part of the jersey, on the left hip. Numbers **must** be returned at the end of the event.

Transponders

This event will be electronically timed. Riders must fit a transponder to their bike forks, as shown below. Riders will be supplied with two cable ties, extra cable ties are available. It is recommended that entrants bring their own pliers to remove the transponder at the end of the event. Transponders **must** be returned at the end of the event. Riders returning transponders to Cycling Victoria after the event will be charged a \$20 administration fee. Lost or damaged transponders will result in a \$130 charge invoiced to the rider.



Toilets

Toilets are a short walk to the Studley Park Boathouse. The path is located opposite the entrance to Yarra Boulevard from Studley Park Road.

The main road in yellow at the bottom of this map is Johnston St (route 34), which becomes Studley Park Drive (same route number). Heading eastward, the entrance to Yarra Boulevard is after the bridge crossing the Yarra River.

West-bound traffic along Studley Park Drive is advised to turn left at Walmer Street and follow Yarra Boulevard around.

Please allow extra time to get to the circuit, as the roads are busy around this area on a Sunday.
